Important Information

• UKC Rules: The Utah UKC Nosework Club highly recommends that all exhibitors become familiar with the rules for UKC Nosework trials. The complete rulebook is available to download from the UKC website: www.ukcdogs.com

• * **Refund Policy:** Entry fees will be refunded for bitches in season, upon receipt by the Trial Secretary, of a request and a letter from your veterinarian. The Trial Secretary must receive the request prior to the trial date. Any requests made after the trial date will not be honored. There will be no refund for dogs that are excused from the trial site on the day of the trial for any reason. All entry fees will be refunded if this trial is canceled due to COVID regulations, facility policies or at the club's discretion to keep everyone safe..

• Substitution Policy: Substitution of dogs will be allowed.

• Move Up Policy: Move Ups will be allowed between trial days.

• **Trial Cancellations:** No entry fees will be refunded if the Trial cannot open or be completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, or any other causes beyond the control of the club, trial committee or trial secretary.

• Entry Confirmation: Entry Confirmation will be made as soon as practical after receipt of Pre-Entries. If you do not receive your confirmation by the Saturday preceding these events, please notify the Trial Secretary.

• Please Note: There will be NO odor resets in a class. A handler can NOT handle more than one dog in the same Odor class. If a handler would like to enter more that one dog in the same class, each dog must have a different handler, since the location of the hide is known after the first dog is run.

• Video/Photos: You may video or take photos, though we ask that these not be shared or posted online until after the class is complete.

This trial will be limited to 150 runs per day. A wait list will be available.

General Information for Filling Out Entry Forms

A and B Sections: Exhibitors must specify on the entry form if they are going to compete in the A or B section for each search. Both sections will have the exact same search.

- *A Section* is for dogs that are completely new to the sport of nosework and do not have a title in either UKC or an equivalent title in another organization, such as NACSW or AKC.
- *B Section* is for all other dogs. If you have an equivalent title in another nosework organization, such as NACSW or AKC, you must compete in the B Section. If you are a licensed or professional dog trainer, nosework instructor, or a person licensed to officiate nosework in any organization you must compete in the B section whether or not you have a nosework title. Once you receive a title you can continue to show in the B section. See page 8 of the rule book for any clarification on A and B classes.
- *For your planning purposes:* You need two (2) passes (qualifying runs) in an element to receive the element title. You need three (3) Passes in Handler Discrimination to title.
- Our official UKC Nosework Entry form MUST be used for all entries.

Awards

- A Qualifying ribbon will be awarded to all qualifiers.
- A *Placement ribbons* will be awarded for first through fourth place in each element in the A and B sections.
- A *Title Ribbon* will be awarded to dogs who have passed two legs in any element, or 3 legs in Handler Discrimination.
- A *Title Rosette* will be awarded to dogs who have passed all four element titles in a level.
- *Pins* will be awarded to dogs who attain their first title per level. (Only one pin per dog is awarded per level.)

• *Steward:* We need everyone's help!! You can help work an element after your dog has run too. Being a volunteer is a great way to watch and learn!! We have \$5 vouchers for working 3 classes! Footing/Surfaces

• Footing is mostly concrete, grass and gravel. No stairs are required for any searches.

Snacks & Water Provided for Workers

Notice to Exhibitors

1. All events are held under the rules and regulations of the United Kennel Club, Inc. By entering this trial exhibitors acknowledge they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport.

2. Absolutely no alcoholic beverages or illegal drugs will be allowed on the grounds or building of a licensed UKC event.

3. It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In that case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

4. The UKC Utah Nosework Club, their agents, and their club members assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injuries sustained by spectators or exhibitors, to any of their dogs or property, and further assume no responsibility for injury to children not under the control of their parents or guardians. The UKC Nosework Club is not responsible for loss, accidents or theft.

5. Dog and handler teams may arrive anytime after 7:30 A.M. and prior to the morning judge's briefing and walk through. Dog and handler teams not required for further judging may leave.

6. The "No Smoking" rule will be strictly enforced in all areas.

7. Exhibitors and dog owners are required to clean up after their own dogs. Any person witnessing a violation of this rule must report it to the Event Committee. The Event Committee may ask any person violating these rules to leave the event grounds. No refund will be made if the Exhibitor is asked to leave the grounds.

8. The UKC will vigorously support any motel that files a complaint about exhibitors that fail to keep their dogs quiet and/or fail to clean-up after them. In order that the bad conduct does not spoil it for the majority of responsible exhibitors; UKC will take strong disciplinary action against any offenders.

9. Crating will be announced when we get those details worked out for both locations.
Please bring a rug or mat to put under your crate if indoors. Remember to bring shade for your car!
NOTE: If crating in your car, it is your responsibility to keep track of the running order board to make sure you are ready for your search.

10. Dogs must be kept on a leash no longer than 6 feet in length when walking on the show grounds. A nosework trial is not an activity where dogs should socialize. Please give all dogs space! Longer lines and flexi leashes may be used only during a search and are NOT ALLOWED for walking. Handlers will be given time to change leashes if needed before the search.
